

Ordinance Establishing Districts for the Arkansas Cherokee Nation aka Chickamauga Cherokee of Arkansas

Pursuant to the Arkansas Cherokee Nation Constitution this ordinance establishes and names the districts in present-day Arkansas and authorizes the assignment of citizens to these districts in which they live. Citizens living outside of the State Of Arkansas shall be assigned to the District deemed nearest to them by the Enrollment Office.

- 1) **Chief Black Fox District** shall consist of the following counties in Arkansas: Logan, Yell, Perry, Montgomery, Garland, Hot Spring, Pike, Clark, Hempstead, and Nevada;
- 2) **Chief Glass District** shall consist of the following counties in Arkansas: Boone, Marion, Baxter, Newton, Searcy, Stone, Franklin, Johnson, Pope, Conway, Van Buren, Cleburne, and Faulkner;
- 3) **Chief Bowles District** shall consist of the following counties in Arkansas: Scott, Polk, Sevier, Howard Little River, Miller, Lafayette, and Columbia;
- 4) **Chief Ross District** shall consist of the following counties in Arkansas: Benton, Carroll, Washington, Madison, Crawford, and Sebastian;
- 5) **Chief Tollantusky District** shall consist of the following counties in Arkansas: Pulaski, Saline, Lonoke, Prairie, Monroe, Grant, Jefferson, Arkansas, Phillips, Dallas, Cleveland, Lincoln, Desha, Ouachita, Calhoun, Bradley, Drew, Union, Ashley and Chicot;
- 6) **Chief Dragging Canoe District** shall consist of the following counties in Arkansas: Fulton, Randolph, Clay, IZard, Sharp, Lawrence, Greene, Independence, Craighead, Mississippi, Jackson, Poinsett, White, Woodruff, Cross, Crittenden, St. Francis, and Lee.

A copy of the district map is made a part of this ordinance. The Arkansas Cherokee Nation Council shall assign a councilman a district to be in charge of and to represent for his term in office.

The Councilmen shall have the authority to appoint a "County Headman" for each county or group of counties in their respective districts to represent them and assist them in any way they deem necessary, including holding meetings and etc. These appointments shall be at the pleasure of the Councilman and may be terminated at anytime by the councilman making the appointment or the three chiefs. The name, address and phone number of each appointee shall be forwarded to the tribal office and must be confirmed by the executive committee.

The Emergency Clause: The passage of this ordinance being deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and the same shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon approval.
